

DRYC INTER CLUB FISHING TOURNAMENT



2011 Rules

Entrants:

Any angler who is a member of a Yacht or Fishing Club may participate in the tournament.

Entry Fee:

\$80.00 per attendee, except \$45.00 for children 12 and under. Every person on a participating boat or otherwise attending the events subject to the Entry Fee.

Applications:

The DRYC Anglers Committee must receive all applications no later than August 5, 2011. There will be a limit of 30 boats and 70 attendees, and applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. The granting of applications is strictly within the discretion of the DRYC Angler's Committee.

Eligible Fish:

Only the following fish are eligible for prizes and trophies: Calico Bass, Yellowtail, and White Sea Bass. Calico Bass must be brought to the weigh in alive, weighed and successfully released alive. Yellowtail and White Sea Bass must be weighed in fresh, not in frozen state.

Tackle:

Any type of fishing line and leader may be utilized. There is no restriction on bait or chumming. The only restrictions are no catching by netting, spear fishing or dynamiting. All California Fish & Games Regulations are to be followed

Weigh In:

The weigh in will be on the Angler's boat between 4:00 PM and 5:00 PM, which must be on a mooring or Anchored in Cat Harbor no later than 4:00PM on the day of the tournament. All boats requesting weigh-in must contact tournament committee on channel 71 upon anchoring or mooring.

Moorings:

Contact the Cat Harbor Patrol boat on VHF Channel #9 for mooring. Sharing of Moorings is encouraged (Side Tie) Good Anchorage is available in Cat Harbor.

Fishing Area:

Fish may be caught during fishing times anywhere within a 40 mile radius of Cat Harbor.

Fishing Times:

Eligible fish must be taken only on the day of the tournament, between 7AM & 4PM, anywhere within the designated Fishing Area.

Prizes:

A prize will be awarded to the Anglers who weigh in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd heaviest Calico Bass, and then successfully release the fish alive. The same applies to Yellowtail and White Sea Bass, only the fish need only to be fresh (not frozen). An Angler winning in any place for a specific species is not eligible to win in any other place for the same species. The determination of awards is within the sole discretion of the Anglers Committee.

Trophies:

Subject to the above requirements, the Angler weighing in the heaviest Calico Bass, Yellowtail and White Sea Bass will receive a first place trophy. The club who's member-angler weighs in and releases alive the heaviest Calico Bass will be presented with a Perpetual Club Trophy, to keep until the next DRYC Inter-Club Fishing Tournament.

Captains Mtg:

All Anglers are encouraged to attend the Captains meeting and no host cocktail party on Friday evening, commencing at 7:00PM, at the DRYC Cat Harbor Facility. **Bring your own main entree to BBQ on the grills.** Salad, soft drinks and side dishes will be provided.

Awards Dinner:

A Dinner will be provided to each attendee during the Saturday evening awards dinner, to commence at 7:00 PM.
